Fog & Mist Policy

With regard to fog and mist around the course players must use their own judgement as when it is safe to play, as fog can descend and form to various densities anywhere around the course, away from the Clubhouse and the Pro Shop.

However the following Health and Safety guidelines are given for members and visitors playing in competitive, friendly and social golf matches.

- On the first tee, if the large oak tree on the right at the bottom of the hill cannot be **clearly** seen then play should not commence.
- On all par 3's, if the greens flag cannot be **clearly** seen then play should not continue.
- On other par 4 holes, if the white 200 yard marker on the side of the fairways cannot be **clearly** seen then play should not continue.
- On longer par 5 holes, if fog has descended to the **average** distance that a player would normally reach with his selected club, then play should not continue.

In competitions where a starter or course marshal is in place, the Club will ensure they will make a decision in respect of safety on the course and whether the match can start or should be postponed.

Any player choosing to play on the course against the above guidelines will do so at their own risk, and will not be covered by any club insurance should an accident occur.
